



Cooperation agreement between the Jordan Center for Disease Control (Jordan CDC) and Yarmouk University

This agreement aims to organize a framework for cooperation, coordination, and work mechanisms between the two parties in a manner that supports the objectives of this agreement. This is intended to contribute to developing educational, diagnostic health services, community health, and research.

The agreement includes the implementation of joint academic programs, supervision of students in practical courses, conducting scientific research, and collaboration in leveraging the academic and technical expertise of both parties. It also encompasses publishing joint research, exchanging data and publications, and coordinating events, seminars, and conferences at the local, regional, and international levels.

Additionally, the agreement involves proposing joint projects to local, regional, and international donors, developing health information systems, risk management for epidemics, evaluating surveillance systems, analyzing data, and preparing reports related to applied epidemiology, readiness, and emergency response.
